The remaining one installation had a hardware issue and has nothing to do with Ubuntu.

Why don't you migrate to Ubuntu?

Along with this newsletter we are sending you two CDs. One CD contains Ubuntu Linux 9.10 Desktop 32 bit Installation. The second CD contains NGL version 2.4 and files required for NGL installation in Ubuntu. If you want to migrate to Ubuntu based installation please contact us. We will help you step by step to do both Ubuntu Linux and NGL installation on Ubuntu.

What to migrate?

We know that you are very comfortable with your Windows Operating System. But there are a couple of problems you might be facing, for example: frequent break down due to virus, slow performance of the system. Hence we recommend you to migrate your library server alone to Ubuntu Linux. If you want your clients also to be Ubuntu Linux, you are most welcome to the world of Linux.

Things to do before planning migration

Before you do the migration, first take a back up of NGL database. That is the Postgresql database backup. Secondly take a backup of your NewGenLibFiles available in your server's C: Drive. Apart from this you might be having your own files that are present on the server, do not forget to a backup of them. Because when you do Linux installation all the folders and files will be lost.

Install yuuguu from yuuguu.com and sit back. We will do the rest of the installation for you. **Many of you must have experienced the enhanced customer support we are providing through yuuguu.**

Will my existing hardware work on Ubuntu OS?

Ubuntu Linux has a wide support of drivers. There must absolutely be no problem for your barcode scanners to work. However for barcode printers you may have to plug in and see if it works. Ubuntu has a wide support for normal printers, Monitors, VGA cards, Sound cards, and Ethernet cards. They are automatically detected.

You still have your library client machines which are windows based. Hence you can plug your specific hardware like barcode printers to your windows clients.

Can I go for any other flavour of Linux?

The answer is YES. You may even opt to go for CentOS, Open Suse, Debian, Fedora or Red Hat. However we observed that hardware drivers support for Ubuntu is the best. It readily detects printers, Wireless adapters, scanners, Monitors and other hardware devices.

Hence we are recommending Ubuntu. But remember all Linux flavours are beautiful.
